The Frost Independent School District Board of Trustees met in special session on July 28, 2008 at 8:40 p.m. Members present were David Garcia, Larry Kern, Caleb Martin, Josh Martin, Clay Reynolds, Keith Speer, and Cliff Williams. Superintendent Jim Revill and Elementary Principal Becky Melton were also present. 1. The meeting was called to order.
  2. A quorum was established.
  3. The meeting was called to order.
  4. Caleb Martin moved, seconded by Larry Kern to approve the 2008-2009 budget as presented. The motion carried unanimously.
  5. Larry Kern moved, seconded by Josh Martin to approve the 2008-2009 tax rate of \$1.285/\$100 valuation, with \$1.17 for maintenance and operations, and \$0.115 for interest and sinking that will increase the previous year's tax rate by \$0.13. The motion carried unanimously.
  6. Keith Speer moved, seconded by David Garcia to call an election for September 30, 2008 to seek voter approval to increase taxes by \$0.13 for 2008-2009. The motion carried unanimously.
  7. A report was given on the findings of the District Safety Audit.
  8. Caleb Martin moved, seconded by Keith Speer to adjourn at 8:44 p.m. The motion carried unanimously.
